

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No.5) Regulations, 1970

Made the 6th day of April, 1970

Coming into operation on the 20th day of April, 1970.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along Les Croutes, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Les Gravées to its junction with Stanley Road, otherwise than from North to South.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of section one of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970(c), a person in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along La Couperderie, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from West to East.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including these Regulations.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No.5) Regulations, 1970.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy and shall continue in force until the nineteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but it is intended to indicate their general purport)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the 20th April, 1970:-

- (a) Les Croutes, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street from its junction with Les Gravées to its junction with Stanley Road, traffic being required to proceed in a southerly direction only, i.e. from Les Gravées to Stanley Road; and
- (b) La Couperderie, Saint Peter Port, will continue to be a one-way street, but traffic will now be required to proceed in an easterly direction.
