The Fishing (Prohibited Area) Order, 1970

THE STATES SEA FISHERIES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, hereby orders:-

1. The northern portion of Havelet Bay bounded by the Castle Pier to the north, Castle Cornet to the east and an imaginary line drawn between the southern extremity of Castle Cornet and the eastern extremity of the States Slaughterhouse and Cold Stores to the south and west is hereby a designated area to be used for experimental purposes.
2. No person shall, at any time, take any mussel from poles set within the area specified in section one of this Order.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order may be cited as the Fishing (Prohibited Area) Order, 1970.
5. This Order shall come into force on the sixth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy.
