The Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment)

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections sixteen, eighteen, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969 hereby orders:-

Amendments.

1. The Post Office (Inland Post) Order 1969 is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) subsection (2) of section seventeen by the deletion of the words "ten shillings" and the substitution therefor of the words "two pounds",

(b) section nineteen by the deletion of the words "four pounds" and the substitution therefor of the words "five pounds", and

(c) subparagraph (4) of paragraph 3 of Part II of the Second Schedule thereto by the insertion immediately after the words "any one postal packet" of the words "except where the value of each coin exceeds its face-value".

2. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) Order 1970.
