The Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey)  
Order, 1955, Amendment Order, 1970

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1955 (a), as amended, shall have effect as if in the Second Schedule thereto, there were included the following entry:-

"Pennies and halfpennies of the United Kingdom dated before 1968 but not more than 100 years old at the date of exportation, other than coins exported in a quantity not exceeding twenty five (25) pounds by weight."

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment Order, 1970, and shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is for information only and forms no part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit the exportation of pennies and halfpennies of the United Kingdom dated before 1968 other than in a quantity not exceeding 25 pounds by weight to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick and the Isle of Man, except under a licence granted by the States Board of Administration.
