THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS) (No. 8) (REPEAL)
REGULATIONS, 1970.

Made the thirteenth day of August, 1970.


Coming into operation the sixteenth day of August, 1970.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No.8) Regulations, 1970, are hereby repealed.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No. 8)(Repeal) Regulations, 1970.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the sixteenth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but it is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is to restore a two-way traffic system in the Grange from Brock Road to Doyle Road and in Rouge Huis Avenue.
