The Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955
Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1970

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1969, (a) is hereby revoked.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1970 and shall come into force on the sixteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the above Order is that, as from the 16th September, 1970, licences will no longer be required for the importation of cats and dogs from the United Kingdom, Jersey, the other islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey, Eire or the Isle of Man. The importation of cats and dogs from other countries is not permitted until further notice.
