THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS)(No. 11)
REGULATIONS. 1970.

Made the 16th day of October, 1970.

Coming into operation on the 20th day of October, 1970.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along Saumarez Street, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Union Street to its junction with North Clifton, otherwise than from South to North.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 11) Regulations, 1970.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the twentieth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy, and shall continue in force until the nineteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is that for a further period of three months the northern part of Saumarez Street, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street, from its junction with Union Street to its junction with North Clifton.
