The School Attendance Order (Guernsey) Regulations, 1970

Made 9th November, 1970

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 9th November, 1970

THE STATES EDUCATION COUNCIL, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section eighteen of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. The form set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby prescribed as the form in which a school attendance order shall be served upon the parent of a child of compulsory school age by the States Education Council.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the School Attendance Order (Guernsey) Regulations, 1970.

SCHEDULE

The Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970.

School Attendance Order

The States Education Council

Whereas (hereinafter called "the child") is a child of compulsory school age.

And whereas you of the parent* of the child, have failed to satisfy the above Council in accordance with the requirements of the notice served on you by the Council on that the child is receiving efficient full-time education suitable to his her age, ability and aptitude either by regular attendance at school or otherwise:

And whereas, in the opinion of the Council, it is expedient that the child should attend school:

Now therefore you are hereby required to cause the child forthwith to become a registered pupil at the following school:-
