The Fishing (Prohibited Area) (No. 2) Order, 1970

THE STATES SEA FISHERIES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, hereby orders:-

1. The pool commonly known as the Haute Marc on the south west side of Perelle Bay which is marked in blue on a map preserved in the office of the States Sea Fisheries Committee and which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the President of the Committee on the seventeenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, is hereby designated an area to be used for experimental purposes.
2. No person shall, at any time, take any ormer within the area specified in section one of this Order.
3. The Fishing (Prohibited Area) Order, 1969 (a) is hereby repealed.
4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
5. This Order may be cited as the Fishing (Prohibited Area) (No. 2) Order, 1970.
6. This Order shall come into force on the seventh day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order removes the prohibition on the taking of ormers from the two large pools in Pêquerics Bay.
