TELEVISION AND LOCAL SOUND BROADCASTING

The Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1979  
(Channel Islands) Order 1980

Made - - - - 13th February 1980

Coming into Operation 13th March 1980

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 13th day of February 1980

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3(4) of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1979(a) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1979 (Channel Islands) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 13th March 1980.

2. In this Order, the expression "Channel Islands" means the Bailiwicks of Jersey and Guernsey and the territorial waters adjacent thereto.

3. The provisions of the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1979, except subsections (3) to (6) of section 2 and subsections (3) and (4) of section 3, shall extend to the Channel Islands and the references to the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1973(b) and to the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(c) shall be construed as references to those Acts as extended to the Channel Islands by the Independent Broadcasting Authority Act 1973 (Channel Islands) Order 1979(d) and the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(e) respectively.
