The Parking Places (Amendment)(No.2) Order, 1969.

Made the 18th June, 1969

Coming into operation on 30th June, 1969.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1968, as amended (b), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) in paragraph (b) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "D29, D55, D56 and D57" are hereby repealed and the word, letters and figures "D29 and D57" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (c) of section nine thereof immediately after the letter and figure "D6" there are hereby inserted the letter and figures "D10";
- (c) in paragraph (d) of section nine thereof the letter and figures "D10" are hereby repealed and the letter and figure "D9" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (g) of section nine thereof the letter and figure "D9" are hereby repealed;
- (e) in section eleven thereof the words, letters and figures "may park that vehicle in disc parking places No.s D1 to D54, both inclusive" are hereby repealed and the words "may park that vehicle in any of the disc parking places set out in Part I of the First Schedule to this Order" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (f) in the entry relating to disc parking place No. D10 in the third column of Part I of the First Schedule thereto the words, letters and figures "disc parking places Nos. D55 and D56 and" are hereby repealed;
- (g) the entries relating to disc parking places Nos. D55 and D56 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto are hereby repealed.

2. Paragraphs (b), (d) and (f) of section one of the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1968 are hereby repealed.

3. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment)(No.2) Order, 1969

4. This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
