

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS) (No. 3)
REGULATIONS, 1969.

Made the 14th July, 1969.

Coming into operation on 21st July, 1969.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island.

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along La Soucique Lane, the Forest, from its junction with Forest Road to its junction with Villiaze Road, other than from South to North.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets) (No. 3) Regulations, 1969.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 21st day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty nine, and shall continue in force until the 20th day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from 21st July, 1969, La Soucique Lane will be a one-way street from its junction with Forest Road to its junction with La Villiaze Road, traffic being required to proceed in a northerly direction only.
