

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-way Streets)
(No. 7) Regulations, 1969

Made the 13th October, 1969

Coming into operation on 27th October, 1969.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance 1950 (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along:-

- (a) Arsenal Road, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Monument Road to its junction with Brock Road, otherwise than from East to West;
- (b) Millbrook Estate Road, Saint Peter Port, from the house numbered 33 to the house numbered 42, otherwise than in a clockwise direction;
- (c) Les Camps du Moulin Road, Saint Martin's, from its junction with Croix Bertrand to its junction with the Old Mill, otherwise than from North-East to South-West;
- (d) Old Mill Road, Saint Martin's, from its junctions with Les Camps du Moulin Road to its junction with La Route des Camps, otherwise than from South-East to North-West;
- (e) Rue de L'Eglise, Saint Martin's, from its junction with La Grande Rue to the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church, otherwise than from West to East;
- (f) the unnamed road at La Bellieuse, Saint Martin's, from the house known as "The Nook" situate opposite the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church to La Grande Rue, otherwise than from North to South.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No.7) Regulations, 1969.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the Twenty-seventh day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, and shall continue in force until the Twenty-sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the 27th day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine:-

- (a) Arsenal Road, Saint Peter Port, from its junction with Monument Road to its junction with Brock Road, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from Monument Road to Brock Road.
- (b) Millbrook Estate Road, Saint Peter Port, from the house numbered 33 to the house numbered 42, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in a clockwise direction only;
- (c) Les Camps du Moulin Road, Saint Martin's, from the Traffic lights to the Old Mill, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed away from the Traffic lights only;
- (d) Old Mill Road, Saint Martin's, from its junction with Les Camps du Moulin Road to its junction with La Route des Camps, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from the Old Mill towards Queen's Hotel;
- (e) Rue de l'Eglise, Saint Martin's, from its junction with La Grande Rue to the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from the Grande Rue towards Saint Martin's Church;
- (f) the unnamed road at La Bellieuse, Saint Martin's, from the house known as "The Nook" situate opposite the southern gateway of Saint Martin's Parish Church to La Grande Rue, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from Saint Martin's Church to the Grande Rue.
