Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law 1946

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955
Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1969

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import & Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955 (a) as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

In the First Schedule in the item "Animals and other mammals except horses, donkeys, pigs, sheep, goats, dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters and guinea pigs" the words "dogs and cats" are hereby deleted.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1969 and shall come into force on the twenty-ninth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

The effect of the above Order is that it is now prohibited to import all dogs and cats into Guernsey otherwise than under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration.
