The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
(No. 8) Regulations, 1969

Made the 10th October, 1969

Coming into operation on 3rd November, 1969

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine(a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal and driving or riding that vehicle or permitting that animal to proceed from South to North along Victoria Road, Saint Peter Port, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, turn that vehicle or permit that animal to turn to the right at its junction with Grange Road.

2. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal and driving or riding that vehicle or permitting that animal to proceed from West to East along Les Gravées, Saint Peter Port, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, turn that vehicle or permit that animal to turn to the right at its junction with Queen's Road.

3. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including these Regulations.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 8) Regulations, 1969.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 3rd day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, and shall continue in force until the 2nd day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations
but it is intended to indicate their general
purport.)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the 3rd day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, traffic will not be able to turn right from Victoria Road into Grange Road, nor from Les Gravées into Queen's Road, Saint Peter Port.
