

The Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey)  
Regulations, 1969

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation four of the principal regulations.

1. In paragraph (2) of regulation four of the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) Regulations, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal regulations") the words "six days" are hereby repealed and the words "eight days" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and Commencement

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1969, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1969.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventeenth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These regulations amend the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, by providing that the time limit for returning a card which has ceased to be current shall be extended from six days to eight days.
