The Fishing (Prohibited Area) Order, 1969

THE STATES SEA FISHERIES COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, hereby orders:-

1. The pool commonly known as the Haute Mare on the south west side of Perelle Bay and the two large pools in la Baie des Pêqueries all of which are marked in blue on a map preserved in the office of the States Sea Fisheries Committee and which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the President of that Committee on the seventeenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, are hereby designated areas to be used for experimental purposes.

2. No person shall, at any time, take any ormer within any of the areas specified in section one of this Order.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Fishing (Prohibited Area) Order, 1969.

5. This Order shall come into force on the seventeenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.
