

The Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1968

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (4) of section fourteen, section sixty-five and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation one of the regulations of 1964

1. Immediately after regulation one of the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended there is hereby inserted the following additional regulation numbered "1A":-

"Married women who are employed persons

1A (1) A woman who has attained pensionable age shall not be liable, in respect of any period during which she is married and is an employed person, unless, during that period she otherwise elects by notice in writing to the Authority, to pay a weekly contribution in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (2) of section two of the Law.

(2) Nothing in this regulation shall relieve an employer of any liability imposed on him by the Law in relation to employers' contributions.

(3) An election made in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this regulation may be cancelled at any time by giving notice in writing to the Authority to that effect and any such election or such cancellation shall be operative from the beginning of the week in which it is so made or so given:

Provided that such cancellation shall be without prejudice to the right of the person concerned to make any such further election from time to time."

Citation and Commencement

2. These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1968, and these regulations and the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1967, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Married Women) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1968, and shall come into operation on the fourth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
