THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section seventy-two, section seventy-five and subsection (3) of section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the principal regulations

1. In paragraph (1) of regulation five of the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") immediately before the words "the appointed day" there are hereby inserted the words "or after".

Citation and Commencement

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1968, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the fourth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations enable an existing widow pensioner (i.e. a woman who was in receipt of a widow's pension under the repealed Contributory Pensions Laws) who becomes entitled to a widow's basic pension after the 4th January, 1965 to be treated in the same way as she would have been treated had she become entitled to that basic pension on that day as regards making use of her late husband's contribution record which he established under the above-mentioned Laws.
