The Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1968

Made	12th February,	1968
Coming into operation	4th March,	1968

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section thirty-eight and subsection (3) of section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation two of the principal regulations

1. Paragraph (2) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby amended, as follows, that is to say, the full stop at the end of the said paragraph is hereby deleted and a colon is hereby substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there is hereby inserted the following proviso -

"Provided that where in the case of an existing widow pensioner within the meaning of the Social Insurance (Pensions, Existing Beneficiaries and Other Persons) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, an adjustment between sickness benefit or unemployment benefit and widow's benefit (other than widow's basic pension) is required to be made as aforesaid for any period then the amount payable in respect of one of those benefits shall not be less than the amount of a widow's basic pension appropriate to a woman of her age."

Citation and Collective Title

2. These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1968, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968.

Commencement

3. These regulations shall come into operation on the fourth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations give added protection to an existing widow pensioner (i.e., a widow who was in receipt of a widow's pension under the repealed Contributory Pensions Laws) by permitting her partially to duplicate the receipt of either sickness benefit or unemployment benefit with widow's benefit.
