

IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946

The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955

Amendment Order 1968

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946 hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955 (a) as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

In the First Schedule the item "Animals and other mammals" is hereby deleted and the following item substituted therefor -

"Animals and other mammals except horses, donkeys, pigs, sheep, goats, dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters and guinea pigs".

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Amendment Order, 1968 and shall come into force on the thirteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is for information only and forms no part of the Order)

The effect of the above Order is that it is no longer necessary to obtain an Import Licence from the Board of Administration to import horses, donkeys, pigs, sheep, goats, dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters or guinea pigs into Guernsey from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other islands of the Bailiwick or the Isle of Man.
