The Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1968

Made on 5th June, 1968.

Coming into operation 10th June, 1968.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1968(b), is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph (a) of section nine thereof, the letter and figures "D19" are hereby repealed and the letter and figures "D21" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (b) of section nine thereof, the word, letter and figures "and D29" are hereby repealed and a comma and the word, letters and figures "D29, D55 and D56" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) paragraph (f) of section nine thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(f) in disc parking place No. D20 -

(i) during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business save that a person, being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle, may park that motor delivery vehicle in that disc parking place for any continuous period not greater than a period of one hundred and twenty minutes during the said hours, or

(ii) during the hours in which the Public Markets are not open for business for any continuous period greater than a period of ten hours during the said hours;"

~~(d) in the entry relating to disc parking place No. D40 in the third column of Part I of the First Schedule thereto immediately after the word "excluding" there are hereby inserted the words and numbers "disc parking places Nos. D55 and D56 and";~~

~~(e) the entries relating to disc parking place No. D19 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto are hereby repealed;~~

~~(f) immediately after the entries relating to disc parking place No. D54 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Schedule to this Order.~~

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1968.

SCHEDULE

"D55 Albert Pier, Saint Peter Port.

The south side of the Albert Pier between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the top of the slipway and a parking sign placed as near as may be in line with the western side of the States Office Annexe.

D56 Albert Pier, Saint Peter Port.

The south side of the centre of the Albert Pier to the west of the States Office Annexe between parking signs placed thereon."
