The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 12)
Regulations, 1968

Made the 5th June, 1968.

Coming into operation on 10th June, 1968.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of section one of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1956 (c) (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance of 1956"), a person in charge of a vehicle or an animal -

- (a) may drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along that portion of Vauvert, Saint Peter Port, between its junction with Victoria Road and its junction with George Street, in an upward direction;
- (b) shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along George Street, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from South to North, i.e. upwards.

2. (1) In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 12) Regulations, 1968.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the tenth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, and shall continue in force until the ninth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from 10th June, 1968 -

- (a) that portion of Vauvert, St. Peter Port, between its junction with Victoria Road and its junction with George Street, shall be open to two-way traffic; and
- (b) George Street, St. Peter Port, will continue to be a one-way street, but traffic will be required to proceed in a northerly direction, i.e. upwards instead of downwards as hitherto.
