The Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1968

Made on 25th September, 1968.

Coming into operation on 30th September, 1968.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1968, as amended (b), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) in paragraph (b) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "D55 and D56" are hereby repealed and the word, letters and figures "D55, D56 and D57" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) immediately after the entries relating to disc parking place No. D56 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1968.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.
