The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
(No. 14) Regulations, 1968

Made the 5th of December, 1968.

Coming into operation on 9th December, 1968.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine(a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along:-

- (a) La Neuve Rue, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from South to North;
- (b) that portion of Skin's Lane, Saint Peter Port, between its junction with Courtil Bris and its junction with La Neuve Rue, otherwise than from West to East;
- (c) the West, North and East sides of the rectangle formed by part of the Water Lanes, part of Collings Road and two parallel unnamed roads, otherwise than in a clockwise direction.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 14) Regulations, 1968.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight and shall continue in force until the 8th day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from 9th December, 1968:

- (a) La Neuve Rue, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in a northerly direction only;
- (b) that portion of Skin's Lane, Saint Peter Port, between its junction with Courtil Bris and its junction with La Neuve Rue, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in an easterly direction only;
- (c) the West, North and East sides of the rectangle in Saint Peter Port formed by part of the Water Lanes, part of Collings Road and two parallel unnamed roads, will be one-way streets, traffic being required to proceed in a clockwise direction only.
