The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
Regulations, 1967.

Made the 6th January, 1967.

Coming into operation on the 11th January, 1967.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950, as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along:-

- (a) the road forming the western side of the triangle at the junction of Saline Road, Port Soif Road and Grandes Rocques Road, Castel, otherwise than from South to North;
- (b) the road forming the north-eastern side of the said triangle, otherwise than from North-West to South-East.

2. In these Regulations the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1967.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the eleventh day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and shall continue in force until the tenth day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a further period of six months from the 11th January, 1967, the road to the west of the triangle at Grandes Rocques, Castel, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in a northerly direction only. The road to the north-east of the triangle will also be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in a south-easterly direction only.
