THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955

AMENDMENT ORDER, 1967

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955, (a) as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

In the First Schedule thereto is hereby inserted, immediately before the reference to "Animal and poultry excrement" the following additional reference -

"Animals and other mammals except cats and dogs"

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1967, and shall come into force on the eleventh day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of the above order and of the amendment to the Open General Import Licence made on the tenth day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, is that it is now prohibited to import all animals and other mammals (except cats and dogs from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, Jersey and the other Islands of this Bailiwick) otherwise than under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration.
