

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No.6)
Regulations, 1967

Made the 26th June, 1967.

Coming into operation on 1st July, 1967.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine(a), and of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle, or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along:-

- (a) the road to the west of the South Plantation, South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from North to South;
- (b) Pointes Lane, Saint Andrew's, otherwise than from North to South.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No.6) Regulations, 1967.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the 1st July, 1967, the inner road to the west of the South Plantation, South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port, and Pointes Lane, Saint Andrew's, will be one-way streets, traffic being required to proceed in both cases from North to South.
