

The Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1967

Made the 30th June, 1967.

Coming into operation on 10th July, 1967.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. Immediately after section six of the Parking Places Order, 1964, as amended(b), there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered "6A" -

"6A. A person who carries on the business of a dealer in or repairer of vehicles, or who carries on the business of letting vehicles on hire, shall not cause or permit any vehicle in his possession in the course of any such business as aforesaid, whether as owner, bailee or otherwise, to be parked in any disc parking place or any approved parking place, nor shall any servant or agent of his being in charge of any such vehicle cause or permit that vehicle to be so parked."

2. Subsection (2) of section two of the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1967(c), is hereby repealed.

3. This Order, the ~~Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1967~~, and the ~~Parking Places Orders, 1964 to 1966~~, may be cited together as the ~~Parking Places Orders, 1964 to 1967~~.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
