

The Parking Places (Amendment)(No. 4) Order, 1967

Made on 7th September, 1967.

Coming into operation on 14th September, 1967.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. Subsection (2) of section seven of the Parking Places Order, 1964, as amended(b), is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor -

"(2) A person being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle in approved parking place No. A37 except with the permission in writing of the Chief Officer and then only during such period as that person is at sea for the purposes of fishing."

2. Subsection (2) of section three of the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1967, is hereby repealed.

3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (No. 4) Order, 1967.

(2) This Order, the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1967(c), the Parking Places (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1967(d), the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1967, and the Parking Places Orders, 1964 to 1966, may be cited together as the Parking Places Orders, 1964 to 1967.

4. This Order shall come into force on the 14th day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.
