

IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1955AMENDMENT NO. 2 ORDER, 1967

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders as follows:-

1. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1955 (a) as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-

In the First Schedule in the item "Animals and other mammals except cats and dogs" the words "except cats and dogs" are hereby deleted.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Amendment No. 2 Order, 1967 and shall come into force on the twenty-first day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

The effect of the above Order is that it is now prohibited to import all animals into Guernsey otherwise than under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration.
