The Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 54) Order, 1967

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1960, hereby orders:-

1. In the Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 48) Order, 1965, as amended (a), there shall be made in the headings specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order the amendments set out in the second column of that Schedule.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 54) Order, 1967.
(2) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (c) and sub-section (d) of section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1932, as amended, this Order shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

21.07	<p>Insert the following new subheading immediately after the existing subheading (A):-</p> <p align="center">"(B) Yoghourt with added flavouring or fruit 10% Free"</p> <p>and the existing subheading (B) shall be re-lettered (C).</p>
39.02	<p>For the existing subheading (A) there shall be substituted the following:-</p> <p align="center">"(A) Strip not exceeding 4 inches in width coated with adhesive:</p> <p align="center">(1) Suitable for use with embossing devices of subheading 98.07 (B) 10% Free</p> <p align="center">(2) Other 20% Free".</p>
41.02	<p>In subheading (A), after "each" there shall be inserted ", but not including wet blue chrome tanned leather".</p>
44.09	<p>Insert the following new subheading immediately after the existing subheading (A):-</p> <p align="center">"(B) Pulpwood, in the form of chips, with a bulk density of not less than 10 lb. per cubic foot when measured by a loose weight method using the apparatus described in British Standard 812:1960, and of which not more than 5 per cent. by weight passes a sieve having a nominal width of aperture of 2.00 millimetres and conforming to British Standard 410:1962, and imported in consignments of not less than 500 tons each Free</p> <p>and the existing subheading (B) shall be re-lettered (C).</p>
58.07	<p>After the words "Chenille yarn" where they first occur there shall be inserted the words "(including flock chenille yarn)".</p>
62.03	<p>Insert new subheading (A) as follows:-</p> <p align="center">"(A) Used sacks and bags containing 85 per cent or more by weight of jute Free</p> <p>and the existing subheadings (A) and (B) shall be re-lettered (B) and (C).</p>
85.01	<p>(a) In subheading (E), for the letter "(C)", there shall be substituted "(C)(1)".</p> <p>(b) Insert the following new subheading immediately after the existing subheading (E):-</p> <p align="center">"(F) Parts of the goods of subheading (C)(2) above Free</p> <p>and the existing subheadings (F) and (G) shall be re-lettered (G) and (H).</p>
