

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES) ORDER, 1966

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section seven and subsection (1) of section seven A of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. For the purposes of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section seven and of subsection (1) of section seven A of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (a), containers for the export of flowers, fern and other foliage shall be of the types and sizes set out in the First Schedule to this Order.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of this Order containers of the type and size set out in the Second Schedule to this Order may be used for the export of flowers packed in bulk.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. The Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (No. 2) Order, 1965(b) and the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (No. 3) Order, 1965(c), are hereby repealed.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of January nineteen hundred and sixty seven.
