The Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit)
(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1966

Made 10th January, 1966

Coming into operation 10th January, 1966

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (3) of section twelve and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation one of the principal regulations

1. In paragraph (1) of regulation one of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations") there is hereby inserted, immediately after the definition of the expression "the Law", the following definition -

"the standard daily rate of unemployment benefit" means, in relation to a person of any of the descriptions set out in the first column of paragraph 1 of the Second Schedule to the Law, one-sixth of the weekly rate of unemployment benefit which is specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite that description;"

Amendment of regulation seven of the principal regulations

2. Regulation seven of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

(a) in paragraph (a) thereof, the words "interruption of unemployment" are hereby revoked and the words "interruption of employment" are hereby substituted therefor;

(b) paragraph (d) thereof is hereby revoked and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(d) a day shall not be treated as a day of unemployment if it is a day in respect of which a person, notwithstanding that his employment has terminated, continues to receive wages or receives, by way of compensation for the loss of the remuneration which he would have received for that day if the employment had not been terminated, payment of an amount which exceeds the amount arrived at by deducting the standard daily rate of unemployment benefit from two-thirds of the remuneration lost in respect of that day;"

(c) in paragraph (h) thereof, the words "in respect of unemployment" are hereby revoked and the words "in respect of employment" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1965, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966 .

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the tenth day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

The main purpose of these Regulations is to revoke and replace paragraph (d) of regulation 7 of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) Regulations, 1964, so as to provide that certain days shall not be treated as days of unemployment.
