

The Social Insurance (Women Seasonal Workers)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1966.

Made 15th March, 1966.

Coming into operation .. 15th March, 1966.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section nine and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the principal regulations

1. The Social Insurance (Women Seasonal Workers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereafter in these regulations referred to as the "principal regulations") are hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

(a) in paragraph (1) of regulation one thereof, the definition of the expression "ordinarily resident in Guernsey" and the definition of the expression "specified period" are hereby revoked;

(b) regulation two thereof is hereby revoked and the following regulation is hereby substituted therefor -

"2. Subject to the provisions of section nine of the Law (which relates to women seasonal workers) and of these regulations, an employed person who is a woman shall be treated as a woman seasonal worker if -

(a) in the current year she is accepted by the Authority as being employed in seasonal employment; and

(b) she satisfies the Authority that throughout the current year her period of seasonal employment, or her periods of seasonal employment in the aggregate, will amount to not more than twenty-six weeks."

(c) paragraph (2) of regulation three thereof is hereby revoked;

(d) regulation four thereof is hereby revoked and the following regulation is hereby substituted therefor -

"4. A woman shall cease to be treated as a woman seasonal

worker immediately her period of employment as an employed person in the current year, or her periods of employment as an employed person in the current year in the aggregate, exceed twenty-six weeks:

Provided that the Authority may in any particular case extend the said period of twenty-six weeks to such period, not exceeding thirty-two weeks, as the Authority may deem proper".

Citation and commencement

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Women Seasonal Workers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1966, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Women Seasonal Workers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the fifteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
