THE IMPORT DUTIES (BAILLIWICK OF GUERNSEY) (No. 51) ORDER, 1966

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1960, hereby orders:-

1. Article three of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 48) Order, 1965, as amended (a), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) thereof the word "and" at the end of that sub-paragraph is hereby deleted;
- (b) the full stop at the end of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) thereof is hereby deleted and a semi-colon and the word "and" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) immediately after sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) thereof there is hereby inserted an additional sub-paragraph lettered "(c)" -
"(c) in the case of goods grown, produced or manufactured in, and consigned to the Bailiwick from, places in the Republic of Ireland, no duty shall be charged."

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 51) Order, 1966.

(2) This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, and in the Island of Sark as soon thereafter as the provisions of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1960, with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order shall have been complied with.
