The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
(No. 2) Regulations, 1966.

Made the 20th June, 1966.

Coming into operation on the 20th June, 1966.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950, as amended (b), and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island :-

1. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or an animal, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along the road forming the west side of the triangle at Trinity Square, Saint Peter Port, from the premises known as No. 11, Trinity Square to its junction with Upper Mansell Street, otherwise than from South to North.
2. In these Regulations the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended.
3. These Regulations may be cited as The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 2) Regulations, 1966.
4. These Regulations shall come into force on the twentieth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, and shall continue in force until the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but
is intended to indicate their general purport)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a further period of six months from the 20th June, 1966, the road to the west of the triangle at Trinity Square, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in a northerly direction only.
