THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one, section eight and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the principal regulations

1. Part II of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) in paragraph 6 of column (B) thereof -
- (i) the figure "5" is hereby repealed and the figure "6" is hereby substituted therefor;
  - (ii) in sub-paragraph (a) thereof, the words "for the purposes of the employer's trade or business or" and the comma immediately after those words are hereby repealed;
- (b) in paragraph 7 of the said column (B), the figure "6" is hereby repealed and the figure "7" is hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph 13 of the said column (B), the figure "12" is hereby repealed and the figure "13" is hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1966, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the eleventh day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The main purpose of these regulations is to provide that a person employed in employment of a casual nature for the purposes of his employer's trade or business shall be classified as a self-employed person.
