THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES) (No. 2)
ORDER, 1965

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section seven and subsection (1) of section seven A of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. For the purposes of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section seven and of subsection (1) of section seven A of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (a), containers for the export of flowers, fern and other foliage shall be of the types and sizes set out in the Schedule to this Order.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
