

The Road Traffic (One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1965.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended, and of the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or animal, shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle or permit that animal to proceed on or along -

- (a) Saint George Road, Castel, from its junction with Cobo Road to La Haye du Puits, otherwise than from East to West;
- (b) the road leading from Saint George Road, Castel at La Haye du Puits to its junction with Cobo Road, otherwise than from South-West to North-East;
- (c) Cobo Road, Castel, from its junction with Saumarez Road to its junction with Saint George Road, otherwise than from North-West to South-East.

2. In these Regulations the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article 1 of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended.

3. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1965,

(2) These Regulations shall come into force on the twenty-first day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-five and shall operate until the twentieth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations provide for a one-way system of traffic at La Planque, Castel. The effect is that East bound traffic from Cobo may proceed straight along the Cobo Road while West bound traffic from Saint Peter Port must divert via La Haye du Puits.
