

The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1965

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (1) of section two of the European Free Trade Association (Guernsey) Law, 1960, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1960, as amended (a), are hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:-
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (3) of Regulation nine thereof, for the reference to the Customs Tariff, 1959, there is hereby substituted a reference to the Customs Tariff, 1965;
 - (b) in paragraph (4) of Regulation nine thereof, for the definition of the expression "Customs Tariff, 1959" there is hereby substituted the following definition -

" "Customs Tariff, 1965" means the form of customs tariff set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 48) Order, 1965;"
2.
 - (1) These Regulations may be cited as the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1965, and these Regulations and the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1960 to 1963, may be cited together as the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1960 to 1965.
 - (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
 - (3) These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
