THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES) (NO. 3) ORDER, 1965

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section seven and subsection (1) of section seven A of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956, as amended (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Schedule to the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (No. 2) Order, 1965(b), is hereby revoked and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order may be cited as the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (No. 3) Order, 1965.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended  
to indicate its general purport).

This Order amends the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) (No. 2) Order, 1965, which prescribes the types and sizes of the containers to be used for the export of flowers, fern and other foliage from the Island, with effect from the 1st June, 1966, to substitute cardboard and leatherboard containers in sizes 36 ins. x 12 ins. x 5 ins. and 42 ins. x 12 ins. x 5 ins. for such containers in sizes 30 ins. x 14 ins. x 6 ins. and 40 ins. x 12 ins. x 4 ins. respectively.
