The Parking Places (Amendment) (No.2) Order, 1965.

Made the 9th August, 1965.

Coming into Operation on the 20th September, 1965.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1964, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows, that is to say:-

(a) in the entry relating to disc parking place No. D27 in the right hand column of Part I of the Schedule thereto the words "the pump" are hereby repealed and the words "its junction with Grange Road" are hereby substituted therefor and immediately after the word "Frères" there are hereby inserted the words "but excluding approved parking place No. MB14";

(b) the entry relating to disc parking place No. D35 in the right hand column of Part I of the Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following entry is hereby substituted therefor -

"The west and south side of the road between a parking sign placed opposite the premises numbered 4 and a parking sign placed opposite Salem Methodist Church but excluding approved parking place No. MB15.";

(c) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. MB14 in each of the columns of Part III of the Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) (No.2) Order, 1965.

3. This Order shall come into force on the twentieth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
