The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods)

(Amendment No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1965

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section two of the European Free Trade Association (Guernsey) Law, 1960, hereby make the following Regulations:-

1. The European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1960, as amended (a), are hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) Regulation six thereof is hereby repealed and the following Regulation is hereby substituted therefor -
 - "6. (1) Goods shall be treated as consigned from a place in the area if it is shown to the satisfaction of the Board -
 - (a) that those goods have been consigned to the Bailiwick from such a place; or
 - (b) that they
 - (i) have been consigned from such a place to an exhibition outside the area and have been exhibited there, and
 - (ii) are in the same state as they were in when consigned to the exhibition and have not been used otherwise than for the purpose of exhibiting or demonstrating them at the exhibition since they were so consigned; and
 - (iii) have been sold or otherwise disposed of by the consignee to a person in the Bailiwick and have been consigned from the exhibition to the Bailiwick during or immediately after the exhibition; or
 - (c) that they
 - (i) have been consigned from such a place to a Customs warehouse outside the area, and
 - (ii) have remained continuously in that warehouse and no substitution or addition of other goods has taken place, and
 - (iii) have been consigned to the Bailiwick from that warehouse, and
 - (iv) are in the same state as they were in when consigned to that warehouse, and
 - (v) are entered on importation into the Bailiwick within twelve months from the date of their exportation from a place in the area.

"exhibition" means a trade, industrial, agricultural or crafts exhibition, fair or similar show or display, but does not include any such exhibition, fair, show or display organised for private purposes in shops or business premises with a view to the sale of goods foreign to the country where the exhibition is held;

"Customs warehouse" means locked premises or an enclosed space, approved by the appropriate Customs authorities, in which goods may be stored under their control without payment of import duties and taxes, but does not include free ports or free zones."

- (b) in paragraph (4) of Regulation nine thereof, for the definition of the expression "the United Kingdom Regulations" there is hereby substituted the following definition -

" 'the United Kingdom Regulations' means the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) Regulations, 1964, made by the Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section one of the European Free Trade Association Act, 1960."

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the European Free Trade Association (Origin of Goods) (Amendment No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1965.
- (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
- (3) These Regulations shall come into force on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
