THE IMPORT DUTIES (EUROPEAN FREE TRADE ASSOCIATION)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1965

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section two of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Order, 1963, as amended (a), is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) in paragraph (b) of section two thereof the words "seven-tenths" are hereby deleted and the words "four-fifths" are hereby substituted therefor;
 - (b) the Second Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.
2. In subsection (1) of section two of the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1965, the comma immediately after the figures "1965" where those figures first occur is hereby deleted and a full-stop is hereby substituted therefor and all the words and figures after those figures to the end of that section are hereby repealed.
3. (1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Amendment No. 2) (Guernsey) Order, 1965, and this Order and the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1965, and the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Orders, 1963 ~~and~~ 1964, may be cited together as the Import Duties (European Free Trade Association) (Guernsey) Orders, 1963 to 1965.
 - (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
 - (3) This Order shall come into operation on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
