

THE EXPORT OF PRODUCE (OTHER THAN TOMATOES)  
(TEMPORARY) ORDER, 1964.

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR HORTICULTURE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section four of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1956(a), as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. During the continuance in force of this Order the imprint on, or the label attached to, a container of produce to be exported to any consignee in Borough Market, Brentford Market, Covent Garden Market, Spitalfields Market or Stratford Market may, notwithstanding the provisions of section one of the Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (No. 2) Order, 1964(c), be in such form and contain the particulars set out in the Schedule to this Order, may be buff in colour and the cross thereon shall -
  - (a) as respects Borough Market, be green in colour,
  - (b) as respects Brentford Market, be black in colour,
  - (c) as respects Covent Garden Market, be red in colour,
  - (d) as respects Spitalfields Market, be blue in colour, and
  - (e) as respects Stratford Market, be yellow in colour.
2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
3. This Order shall come into force on the second day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and shall continue in force until the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The Export of Produce (Other than Tomatoes) (No. 2) Order, 1964, prescribes the form in which containers of produce, other than tomatoes, for export shall be labelled as from the 2nd March, 1964.

The effect of this Order is to permit the use during the period 2nd March to 30th November, 1964, of buff labels as respects containers of such produce to be exported to consignees in Borough Market, Brentford Market, Covent Garden Market, Spitalfields Market or Stratford Market, provided they contain the particulars set out in the Schedule to the Order.

(NOTE. It had been intended to re-number the salesmen in the above-mentioned Markets, but as this is not possible during the current season, existing stocks of labels for these Markets may be used provided they are overprinted to contain the required particulars.)
