The Milk (Wholesale Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1964.

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by subsection (1) and subsection (3) of section six of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. During the two months commencing on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, the price per pot payable by the States Dairy Committee (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the Committee") in respect of milk delivered to the Committee under the provisions of the Milk Control (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958 (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the Ordinance"), during those months and classified as-

(a) Grade 1 milk -

(i) where such milk is not surplus to the Island's milk requirements, shall be, during each period specified in the first column of Part I of the Schedule to this Order, the price specified in relation to such period in the second column of that Part of that Schedule;

(ii) where such milk is surplus to the Island's milk requirements, shall be such reasonable commercial price as the Committee shall from time to time determine;

(b) Grade 2 milk, shall be one shilling.

2. During the twelve months commencing on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four (hereafter in this Order referred to as "the prescribed period"), the standard price payable by the Committee in respect of Grade 1 milk delivered to the Committee

under the provisions of the Ordinance during the prescribed period which is not surplus to the Island's milk requirements shall be two shillings, eight pence and one farthing.

3. During the prescribed period the price per pot payable by the Committee in respect of milk delivered to the Committee under the provisions of the Ordinance during the prescribed period and classified as -

(a) Grade 1 milk -

(i) where such milk is not surplus to the Island's milk requirements, shall be, during each period specified in the first column of Part II of the Schedule to this Order, the price specified in relation to such period in the second column of that Part of that Schedule;

(ii) where such milk is surplus to the Island's milk requirements, shall be such reasonable commercial price as the Committee shall from time to time determine;

(b) Grade 2 milk, shall be one shilling.

4. The Milk (Wholesale Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1963, is hereby revoked.

5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

6. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Wholesale Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1964, and shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

Wholesale price of milk

PART I

Price per pot payable during the two months commencing on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

The seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, to the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, both dates inclusive.	Two shillings, two pence and one halfpenny.

PART II

Price per pot payable during the prescribed period (the first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four to the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-five).

<u>Period</u>	<u>Price per pot</u>
The first day of July, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, to the twenty-second day of August, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, both dates inclusive.	Three shillings.
The twenty-third day of August, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, to the twelfth day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, both dates inclusive.	Two shillings, eight pence and one farthing.

The thirteenth day of December,
nineteen hundred and sixty-four,
to the sixth day of March, nineteen
hundred and sixty-five, both dates
inclusive.

Two shillings, eleven pence
and three farthings.

The seventh day of March, nineteen hundred
and sixty-five, to the twenty-seventh day of
March, nineteen hundred and sixty-five, both
dates inclusive.

Two shillings, six pence and
three farthings.

The twenty-eighth day of March,
nineteen hundred and sixty-five,
to the twenty-fourth day of April,
nineteen hundred and sixty-five,
both dates inclusive.

Two shillings, three pence
and one halfpenny.

The twenty-fifth day of April,
nineteen hundred and sixty-five to
the fifth day of June, nineteen
hundred and sixty-five, both dates
inclusive.

Two shillings and three pence

The sixth day of June, nineteen hundred
and sixty-five, to the thirtieth day of
June, nineteen hundred and sixty-five,
both dates inclusive.

Two shillings, three pence
and three farthings.
