

The Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1964.

Made... .. 24th August, 1964.

Coming into Operation... .. 1st September, 1964.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers vested in it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1964, is hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

(a) the full stop at the end of section six thereof is hereby deleted and the following words are hereby substituted therefor -

"save that a person, being in charge of a public vehicle, may park that public vehicle in approved parking place No. A 38, ~~or~~ No. A 39, for the purposes of standing or plying for hire.";

(b) section seven thereof is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor -

" 7 (1) A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle other than an omnibus, shall not park that vehicle in approved parking place No. A 1

~~(2) A person, being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle, shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle in approved parking place No. A 37 otherwise than during such period as that person is at sea for the purposes of fishing.~~

(3) A person, other than a person being in charge of a vehicle or a motor bicycle other than a public vehicle standing or plying for hire, shall not park that vehicle or motor bicycle in approved parking place No. A 38, ~~or~~ No. A 39.";

(c) in paragraph (d) of section eight thereof the word, letter and figures "and D 13" are hereby repealed and a comma and the word, letters and figures "D 13, D 43, D 44, D 45 and D 46" are hereby substituted therefor:

(d) paragraph (f) of section eight thereof is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(f) in disc parking places Nos. D 20 and D 21 -

(i) during the hours in which the Public Markets are open for business save that a person, being in charge of a motor delivery vehicle, may park that motor delivery vehicle in either of those disc parking places for any continuous period not greater than a period of one hundred and twenty minutes during the said hours, or

any continuous period greater than a period of ten hours during the said hours;"

(e) in section thirteen thereof all the words from and including the words "with its near side," to the end of that section are hereby repealed and the words "as close as is reasonably practicable to the kerb or the edge of the carriageway, as the case may be." are hereby substituted therefor;

(f) the whole of the entry relating to disc parking place No. D 7 in the third column of Part I of the Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following entry is hereby substituted therefor -

"The landward side of the road between a parking sign placed near the entrance to Pictte Road and a parking sign placed near the entrance to Bouillon Lane.";

(g) the entries thereto relating to disc parking place No. D 8 in each of the columns in Part I of the Schedule are hereby repealed;

(h) in the entry relating to disc parking place No. D 12 in the right hand column of Part I of the Schedule thereto the words "but excluding approved parking place No. A 37" are hereby inserted at the end thereof;

(i) the whole of the entry relating to disc parking place No. D 16 in the third column of Part I of the Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following entry is hereby substituted therefor -

"Both sides of the Square."

(j) immediately after the entries relating to disc parking place No. D 42 in each of the columns of Part I of the Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of Part I of the Schedule to this Order;

(k) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. A 36 in each of the columns of Part II of the Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of Part II of the Schedule to this Order;

(l) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. MB 11 in each of the columns of Part III of the Schedule thereto there are hereby inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of Part III of the Schedule to this Order;

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1964.

3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-four.

SCHEDULE

PART I

- "D43. Ann's Place and Hirzel Street,
Saint Peter Port. The north side of Ann's Place and the west
side of Hirzel Street between a parking sign
placed to the east of the entrance to O.G.H.
Hotel and a parking sign placed near the
garden entrance to O.G.H. Hotel.
- D-44. South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port. ~~The area of the road to the west of the States
Slaughterhouse delineated by white lines marked
thereon by the Island Police Committee.~~ 2
- D 45. Havilland Street, Saint Peter Port. The west side of the road between a parking
sign placed as near as may be to the north
end of the street and a parking sign placed
as near as may be to the house numbered 9.
- D 46. Saint John Street, Saint Peter Port. The east side of the road between a parking
sign placed as near as may be to the house
numbered 8 and a parking sign placed as near
as may be to the premises known as "Melbourne
House". "

PART II

- "A 37 Albert Pier, Saint Peter Port. That part of the east end of the Pier enclosed by chains and indicated by parking signs as being reserved for fishermen at sea.
- A 38 Glatigny Esplanade, Saint Peter Port. The area of the road between Truchot Street and Saint Julian's Avenue and bounded on the east side by a rounded pavement.
- A 39 Albert Pier, Saint Peter Port. ~~That part of the north side of the Pier between a parking sign placed near the Cornought Landing Stone and a parking sign placed to the east thereof.~~

PART III

" MB 12.

~~Le Tourgand, Saint Peter Port.~~

~~The portion of the north side of the road indicated by parking signs as being reserved for motor bicycles.~~

MB 13.

Arsenal Road, Saint Peter Port.

The portion of the west end of the road indicated by parking signs as being reserved for motor bicycles.

MB 14.

Upland Road, Saint Peter Port.

The east portion of the road near its junction with Rue des Freres indicated by parking signs as being reserved for motor bicycles.
