THE ANIMALS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS (IMPORTATION)  
(NO. 2) ORDER, 1964.

---

The States Committee for Agriculture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of section eleven of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952 (a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

1. Sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (b) of section two of the Animals and Animal Products (Importation) (No. 2) Order, 1958 (b) is hereby repealed. Rep. 1964/20
2. Paragraph (c) of section one of the Animals and Animal Products (Importation) (No. 3) Order, 1958 (c), is hereby repealed.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (d), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-sixth day of October, 1964.

This Order removes the requirement that live swine imported into Guernsey from Jersey and Alderney must be vaccinated with crystal violet vaccine.
