

The Central Outdoor Assistance  
Board (Amendment) Regulations, 1963.

The Central Outdoor Assistance Board, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article VI of the Public Assistance Law, 1937, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. The Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1955, are hereby amended as follows, that is to say:-

(a) in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) of Regulation four thereof the words "seven shillings and sixpence" are hereby repealed and the words "fifteen shillings" are hereby substituted therefor;

(b) in sub-paragraph (b) and in sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph three of the Schedule thereto, the words "four hundred" where those words occur are hereby repealed and the words "six hundred" are hereby substituted therefor;

(c) paragraph seven of the Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"7. Where the applicant is the householder, or the husband or wife of the householder, his resources shall, unless exceptional circumstances are shown, be taken to include a contribution towards the expenses of the household from any member thereof who is not a dependant of his of an amount of ten shillings

a week, or of such less amount as is reasonable having regard to the said member's circumstances and personal responsibilities".

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board (Amendment) Regulations, 1963, and these Regulations and the Central Outdoor Assistance Regulations, 1939 to 1957, may be cited together as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1939 to 1963.
3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the day next following their approval by the States.
